

Terms & Conditions for Round She Goes Stall Holders

Please note: by booking and paying for a stall, you agree to abide by these terms and conditions. Further instructions are emailed to stallholders 10 days before the market date.

Content of your stall

The goods for sale must be in good salable condition. They don't have to be strictly designer but they do have to be in good, wearable condition. Vintage is (of course) welcome. Perfume and unused authentic cosmetics are okay. It's very important to consider before you apply that very cheap clothes from discount department stores have no resale value.

What you can sell

Preloved stuff can include: hats, bags, shoes, suits, jeans, pants, skirts, tops and dresses but must be quality goods.

What you can not sell

Absolutely no counterfeits either perfume, bags or clothing, sports gear, t-shirts, men's or childrenswear, you also can't sell food, used cosmetics or candles. No bric-a-brac – eg: CDs, glassware, prints etc are not permitted.

Bookings

Once an application is approved, stalls must be secured with \$85.00 stall fee payment within 5 days. 50% cancellation fee applies. There are no refunds for cancellations up to 2 months prior to the market.

Supervising your stall

Round She Goes will not be held liable for loss, theft or damage to your garments on the day. You are responsible for supervising your stand at all times. Ideally, have a friend with you.

Payment

Payment for your stall is to be made via Paypal. Stallholders will receive payment instructions once their application has been approved.

Access to venue / set up:

- RSG is an indoor market.
- Access and set up for stallholders is from **8:00am-9:30am** with the market officially opening to the public at **10:00am. Please be ready to trade by 10:00am.**
- You need to supply your own clothes racks, coat hangers, mannequins, tablecloth, carry bags for customers, along with a float of change for the day.
- You will be supplied with one table and 2 chairs (spare chairs available if needed).
- On arrival, please check in at the front desk.
- You are welcome to do away with your table altogether and just use your clothes racks. If so, please indicate this to us early and we will get your table out the way for you.

Pricing and presentation:

- It is recommended that you price your garments as people can feel uncomfortable asking for the price of everything but be prepared to bargain and negotiate.
- Make sure clothes are washed and ironed and there are no stained or torn garments.
- Please don't go shopping yourself before 10:00am or ask other stallholders to hold something for you. The spirit of the day is having fun not beating the customers to the bargains!

Parking:

- There is parking around the venue but please **acknowledge any parking restrictions**. Parking is at your own risk and any fines incurred are your own responsibility.

Changing rooms:

- There is one changing room for your customers.
- Stallholders are **highly encouraged** to take a deposit or full payment for the garment that is being tried on which is refunded if the customer doesn't buy.
- Round She Goes is **not** responsible for loss or damage to clothes/accessories on the day.

End of day:

Packing up on the day **must** begin at 3:00pm and be complete by 4:00pm. Please put your rubbish in the bins provided and take **everything** with you. Please leave your stall area as you found it in the morning. Anyone who leaves rubbish will not be able to have a stall again at future Round She Goes events.

Other:

- Each stallholder agrees to indemnify Round She Goes against all claims for damages or injury to the property or person of any persons in respect of any claim by any such person arising out of negligence on the part of the stallholder or their agents or servants.
 - Round She Goes accepts no liability for the loss or damage of any kind suffered by any person who enters the Market area and all persons who enter the Market area do so at their own risk.
- Round She Goes is not responsible for stallholder turnover on market day. You agree to be added to the Round She Goes newsletter (which you can unsubscribe to at any stage).

Round She Goes reserves the right to cancel your stall at the operator's discretion.
