



Terms & Conditions for Round She Goes Market Stallholder participation

By applying and paying for a stall spot, stallholders agree to abide by these terms and conditions. A detailed information guide will be emailed to participating stallholders at least 10 days before the market date.

Who the market is for

Stallholders are only permitted to sell women's secondhand fashion. The goods for sale must be secondhand and in excellent, wearable condition. Vintage is (of course) welcome. It's very important to consider before applying that very cheap clothes from discount department stores have zero resale value.

Round She Goes does not accept applications from retail stores selling new/returned stock, seconds or new clearance items. The items sold at Round She Goes must be secondhand vintage, retro or preloved designer. New with tags is okay for a few items as long as the majority of your stock is not like this. The only new items that can be sold are handmade jewellery, accessories, your own label/creations. Stallholders are not permitted to book a stall in order to promote their own events or similar businesses to the market operators.

What stallholders can sell

Preloved stuff can include: hats, bags, shoes, suits, jeans, pants, skirts, tops and dresses but must be quality goods. Perfume and unused authentic cosmetics are okay too.

What stallholders can not sell

Absolutely no counterfeit items that includes perfume, bags or clothing. Stallholders can not sell men's or childrenswear, stallholders also can't sell food, used cosmetics or candles. Bric-a-brac – music items, glassware, prints, etc are NOT permitted. Round She Goes is a women's second hand fashion market, it's not a vintage or general market.

Bookings and payment

Once an application is approved, stalls must be secured with the full stall fee payment within 5 days. Stallholders will receive payment instructions once their application has been approved.

Cancellations

A 50% cancellation fee applies, however there are no refunds for cancellations up to 2 months prior to the market. If you can't make it, then you cannot give your stall to another person without prior approval from Round She Goes organisers. There are no waiting lists for stall spots so only book if you know you can make it on the day. Stalls can not be on sold or sublet.

Insurance

Round She Goes stallholders are covered for public liability insurance. However cover is excluded for stallholders where the individual stallholder has cover provided by an existing Public & Products Liability insurance policy covering their activities as a stallholder.

Supervising your stall

Round She Goes will not be held liable for loss, theft or damage to stallholders' items on the day. Stallholders are responsible for supervising their stand at all times. Ideally, they should have a friend with them.

Access to venue

- RSG is an indoor market (there are no outdoor stalls).
- Access for stallholders to set up is 8:30am with the market officially opening to the public at 10.00am. Please be ready to trade by 10:00am.
- On arrival, stallholders must check in at the front desk before setting up their stall.

Set up

- stallholders need to supply your own clothes racks, coat hangers, mannequins, tablecloth, carry bags for customers, along with a float of change for the day.
- 1 table and 2 chairs are provided. The table size is 1800mm x 750mm.
- stallholders are permitted not to use the supplied trestle table and just use their clothes racks. A third rack can be used in this instance.
- **One stall** includes a trestle table (that we supply) and enough room for 2 standard-sized clothing racks maximum (you can opt to not have a table if you wish).
- A standard rack has **one rail** on it. The racks go on each side of your table. You must supply your own racks, we do not have racks available for hire.

Pricing and presentation

- It is recommended that stallholders price their garments as people can feel uncomfortable asking for the price of everything but be prepared to bargain and negotiate.
- Make sure clothes are washed and ironed and there are no stained or torn garments.
- Please don't go shopping yourself before 10:00am or ask other stallholders to hold something for you. The spirit of the day is having fun not beating the customers to the bargains!

Parking

- Because the Woodville Town Hall is right across from the Woodville Railway station, there is STACKS of free parking on weekends opposite the hall. There is also a large car park

behind the hall. Round She Goes are not responsible for your fines if you are unlucky enough to get one!

Changing rooms

- Change rooms are provided for customers.
- Stallholders are highly encouraged to take a deposit or full payment for the garment that is being tried on which is refunded if the customer doesn't buy.
- Round She Goes is not responsible for loss or damage to clothes/accessories on the day.

End of day

Packing up on the day must begin at 3:00pm and be complete by 4:00pm. Please put your rubbish in the bins provided and take everything with you. Please leave your stall area as you found it in the morning. Anyone who leaves rubbish will not be able to have a stall again at future Round She Goes events.

Other

- Each stallholder agrees to indemnify Round She Goes against all claims for damages or injury to the property or person of any persons in respect of any claim by any such person arising out of negligence on the part of the stallholder or their agents or servants.
- Round She Goes accepts no liability for the loss or damage of any kind suffered by any person who enters the Market area and all persons who enter the Market area do so at their own risk.
- Participating stallholders agree to be added to the Round She Goes newsletter (they can unsubscribe to at any stage).
- Round She Goes reserves the right to cancel a stall at the operator's discretion.

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
